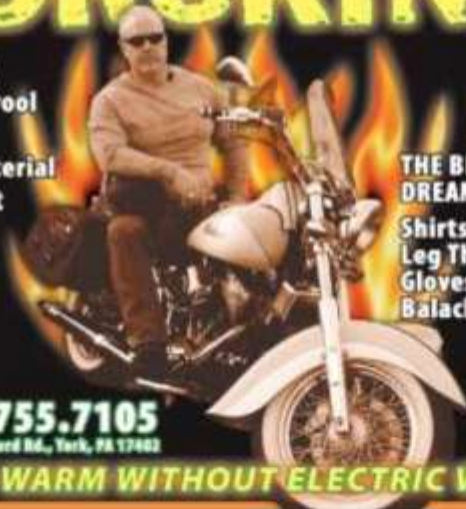

## SAFETY IS FOR LIFE



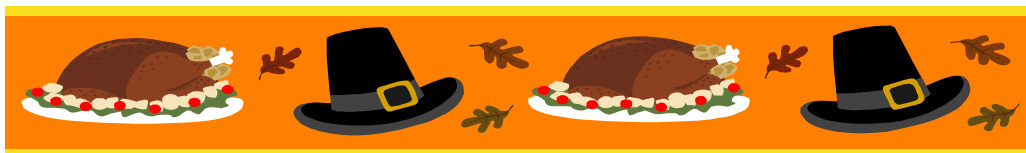
