A couple of months ago I purchased a Garmin Zummo 550 and really love it. I would never go any place without a GPS. A couple weeks ago I went to a friends place in Frederick Maryland and I was never there before and my Zummo got me there without any problems and all I used was his street address. The Zummo is easy to use and you can operate it with gloves. If you have a destination punched in it will give you your current speed and arrival time and gives you the distance in miles before you have to turn and if you miss a turn it recalculates itself. You can find food, fuel, hotels, hospitals, banks and even Dairy Queens with just a couple of clicks. If anyone wants a demo just ask me and I will be happy to show you.
