Life -- a learning experience!

I was 21 when I was hired at Clarion State College. (The name change is just one more thing that reminds me that I've been there a long time!) At that time, I remember seeing the families who were visiting Clarion and thinking to myself, "This year's freshmen are pretty cute!" As time passed, and more new students and their parents came onto campus, I realized that I had the occasional thought, "Gee, that guy's Daddy is a handsome fellow!" Sadly, I've discovered that when I do the math, I am old enough to be the freshman's Grandmother. Not "Mother," mind you. Grandmother!

The college coeds may not realize it, but you continue to acquire knowledge after graduation. I'm particularly fond of the statement, "You'll learn something new every day, if you're not careful." For instance...

In 2007, Gary invited me to attend a rally in Rapid City, South Dakota. I had recently purchased my Gold Wing and trailer and was eager to try them out! Travelling west on Interstate 80, Gary learned that I had never been on an Interstate highway with a motorcycle. He also learned that I had never pulled a trailer before.

As we approached the London, Ohio exit, we thought it was about time to take a break, get some fuel, and check the weather report since the sky was filling with storm clouds. As we slowed to exit, and the wind noise decreased, my radio started making an irritating noise. Turning the radio volume down, I noticed that the noise got louder. Hmmm. "Hey, Gary..." I said, "I think I have a problem." He slowed down to let me pass him then came back on the CB to say, "Holy Crap! I'll say you have a problem! Your trailer is dragging on the road!"

We came to the end of exit ramp, pulled to the side of the road, and dismounted. Sure enough! The tongue of the trailer was resting on the road. The hitch ball is connected to the bike with a bolt that is "built in" to the ball. When I inspected my rig, the bolt and nut were gone! The ball was locked into the trailer tongue with about 3/4" metal ground from the bottom of the ball. Wanting a better look, I disconnected the safety

chains from the bike, picked up the trailer tongue and touched the ball as I pointed out the part that had ground away. That's when I burned my finger and learned that friction causes heat. Make that: a LOT of heat!

I learned a lot of things on the Rapid City trip. I learned that a real, true friend will ride in the pouring rain to fetch a replacement hitch ball. I learned that the old biker's adage, "Never pass up a chance to get gas and go to the bathroom," is sooo true. I learned that gas stations are few and far between when crossing the plains. I learned that the "Badlands" are beautiful and incredibly hot. I learned that I may never master the art of backing up with a trailer attached. I learned how to ride the highway when the winds are blowing you and your bike into a severe lean. I learned that Mount Rushmore isn't nearly as large as I had imagined.

Life - all of it - is a learning experience. Some things are learned the hard way but every lesson should be remembered and cherished. The sum of our experiences makes up who we are and the older we get the more wisdom we collect.

It has been a great pleasure working with all of you. We have been a part of the Pennsylvania District team for so long, it will be a huge change for us. We will always be there for you.

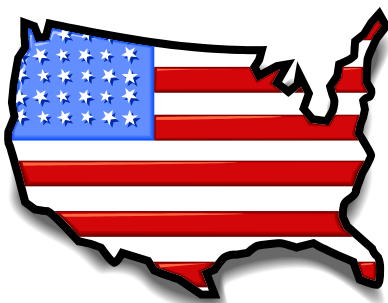

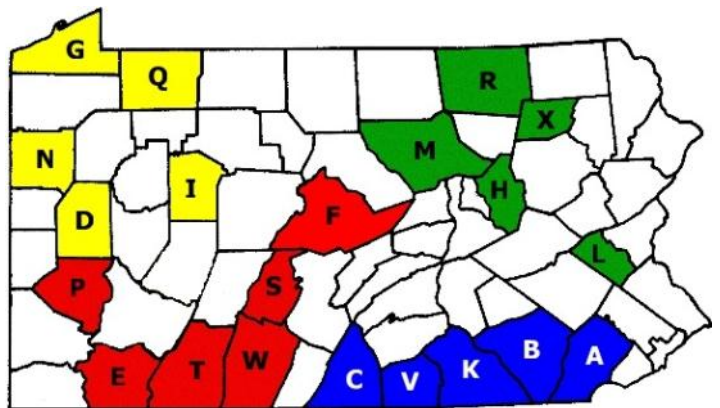

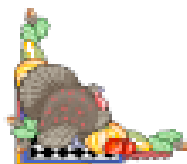
